



CONTINUING MINISTERIAL DEVELOPMENT FOR CLERGY

Extract from CMD-C Policy February 2007

A limited sum of money is available to clergy to help fund attendances at courses, conferences, retreats etc. Clergy may claim up to £150 per year by means of a simple form. Clergy seeking larger grants must write a letter of application which will be considered at a meeting of the Council for Ministry Grants Panel which will meet once per quarter.
